






## COLLEGE HOUR RESOLUTION


- Whereas,** Campus involvement in co-curricular activities promotes campus life and campus cohesion; and
- Whereas,** Campus life is an important and integral part of one's academic experience as a student; and
- Whereas,** Co-curricular activities resulting from a vibrant campus life enhances one's learning and supplements the knowledge gleaned from text-books and class-room activities; and
- Whereas,** Involvement in co-curricular activities produces well-rounded individuals by providing opportunities to develop various skills including one's leadership skills, communication skills, organizational skills, interpersonal skills, and the ability to be a team player; and
- Whereas,** Individuals with varied experiences have increased potential for career growth and promotability; and
- Whereas,** Well-rounded individuals with multi-dimensional abilities are more attractive to job recruiters; and
- Whereas,** A vibrant campus life helps foster campus pride and is a factor in attracting students; and
- Whereas,** The absence of a period time that is consistently set aside for co-curricular activities is detrimental to the prospects of a vibrant campus life; and
- Whereas,** The institution of College Hour will enable students and faculty to meet without the constraint of an inflexible schedule; and
- Whereas,** California State University, Hayward lacks sufficient campus life; be it therefore
- Resolved,** The Associated Students Board of Directors recommend that the California State University, Hayward set aside a time period as College Hour during which no classes shall be scheduled; be it further




Resolved, That copies of this resolution be sent to the University President, Vice Presidents, Chair of the Academic Senate, and all Academic Senators.




