Communication

The Communication Department will pilot the assessment of three learning outcomes, Spring Quarter, 2004. The three outcomes are:

- 1. Knowledge: Students will develop and demonstrate critical methods of analysis of messages
- 2. Skills: Students will develop and demonstrate competence in advanced critical thinking skills for creation and analysis of communication;
- 3. Disposition: Students will develop and demonstrate their curiosity and conscience by asking questions for clarity, comparison, and connection and perceptively reflect back their responses.

These outcomes will be assessed at the entry level in Communication 2100 and at the exit level in Communication 4875. Rubrics for each of these outcomes will be developed and used with assignments embedded in each course.
