

Eligible students who return the WUE Participation Agreement Form prior to the quarterly fee payment deadline will be charge WUE fees. Forms received after this date will have WUE fees posted starting in the following quarter.

**WUE Guidelines**

- WUE students are not eligible for California resident state university fees. Students cannot apply time accrued while participating in the WUE program to establish California residency.
- Students may receive the WUE tuition rate until completion of a bachelor's degree.
- Students with a pre-nursing or nursing major, or a pre-business or business major are not eligible to participate in WUE.
- Students must be enrolled fulltime (12 units or more) while in the WUE program.

**What is WUE?**

WUE is the Western Undergraduate Exchange, a program of the Western Interstate Commission for Higher Education (WICHE). Through WUE, students in Western states may enroll in participating four-year college programs at a reduced fee level. Cal State East Bay is a WUE member institution and offers fulltime students with residency in WUE states tuition at 150% of the regular resident state university fees.

**Is WUE available to graduate students?**

No. Only undergraduate students are eligible to participate in WUE.

**Can a WUE student select any of Cal State East Bay's majors?**

Students can select any undergraduate major with the exception of pre-nursing or nursing, and pre-business or business.

**Do I need to apply to be part of the WUE program?**

Yes. To participate, students with legal residency in a state participating in WUE must submit the WUE Participation Agreement Form (on back) to receive the WUE tuition rate.

**How does WUE participation impact my ability to become a California resident?**

WUE students are not eligible for California resident tuition. Students cannot apply time accrued while participating in the WUE program to establish California residency.

**What if I don't want to be a WUE student?**

You are not required to participate in the WUE program. If you prefer to pay non-California resident fees, simply do not send in the WUE Participation Agreement Form. If you have already signed up to be part of WUE and now wish to withdraw from the program, contact the Office of Admission at (510) 885-2784 or e-mail [admissions@csueastbay.edu](mailto:admissions@csueastbay.edu) and ask to be removed from the WUE program.
