CRITERIA FOR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS:

- *California high school graduate OR transfer student admitted to Cal State East Bay for Fall Quarter 2010 or Winter Quarter 2011*
- *Meet minimum CSU admission requirements*
- *California resident*
- *Enroll in a minimum of twelve units per term*

APPLICATION PROCESS

- Submit application and documents required for admission to Cal State East Bay, including final transcript(s) necessary for final admission consideration. **Only admitted CSUEB students can be selected.***
- Submit 2010/2011 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) listing Cal State East Bay, Title IV code 001138 to the FAFSA processor online:

- Submit complete Future Scholar application when it becomes available:*
